

Jupiter, FL. Itinerary

(Taken from a Local)

NEARBY AIRPORTS: Palm Beach International Airport (ideal) and Miami International Airport (1.5 hour drive)

TRAIN: The Brightline (High-Speed-Rail Train) connects through Miami, Aventura, Fort Lauderdale, Boca Raton, Orlando and West Palm Beach

DAY 1	MORNING:	Grab a coffee and breakfast at Papa Kwan's then take a scenic drive up A1A all the way up to Jup. Island with the windows down.
	AFTERNOON:	Pick up a Pub Sub from Publix and spend the day at the beach! I recommend Juno Beach, Blowing Rocks, and Coral Cove Park.
	EVENING:	Enjoy a dinner at U-Tiki and walk a few doors down afterwards for some late night drinks and dancing at Square Grouper.
DAY 2	MORNING:	Venture up to Tequesta for breakfast at Perk Coffee House then go take a tour at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse.
	AFTERNOON:	Go to an afternoon spring training game at Roger Dean Stadium then wander over to Civil Society for some great local beer.
	EVENING:	Head to Leftovers for dinner; get the sweet potato crusted fish and I promise you will not have any leftover! Or go to the Abacoa food trucks (2nd & 4th Friday of the month).
DAY 3	MORNING:	Go on a coffee walk at the beach. Start at the Juno Beach pier and walk all the way to the Reef Club and back.
	AFTERNOON:	Rent out a <u>Pontiki</u> party boat for the afternoon! This is the best way to have fun with friends and hop around all of the sandbars.
	EVENING:	Have dinner at Papichulo for some tacos and margaritas or go to Blackbird for upscale modern Asian fusion.
DAY 4	MORNING:	Rent out paddle boards/kayaks from <u>Blueline</u> and explore the intracoastal! Go in the morning before boat traffic gets too busy.
	AFTERNOON:	Have lunch at Dune Dog and head back to the beach for another day in the sun
	EVENING:	Indulge in a special night renting out a <u>Food Yacht</u> cruise. Enjoy fresh food and local catches while cruising through the intercostal. I love going during the holidays so you can see all of the houses along the water decorated with lights!
